Plant Descriptions (updated 4/10/08)

Abelia x grandiflora 'Kaleidoscope'

Evergreen shrub 2-3' tall x 3-4' wide w/yellow variegated lvs & white flwrs summer-fall. Sun/Light shade. Moderate water. Hardy to <15 degrees F

Abutilon megapotamicum 'Victory'

Shrub: Semi-evergreen perennial. Great in borders, containers and hanging baskets. Attracts butterflies and hummingbirds. Has drooping bell-like flowers. Bloom time: spring-fall. Bloom color: deep yellow. Compact & floriferous. Size: 4-5' x 4-5'. Prune during growing season. Exposure: sun/part shade. Water: moderate. USDA Z5.

Acacia stenophylla (std.)

Evergreen tree to 30' tall by 20' wide w/unusual narrow gray foliage. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Yellow flwrs in spring. Hardy to 20-25 degrees F

Adenanthos sericea 'Coral Drift'

Evergreen fine textured low shrub 18-24" tall by 3-5' wide w/gray leaves & red flowers in spring/fall. Full sun. Drought tolerant. 20-25 degrees F. [*Adenanthos cuneata*]

Aeonium 'Purple'

Succulent to 3' tall w/purple rosettes & yellow flowers in summer. Full to part sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 25-30 degrees F.

Agapanthus 'Fredrick Street Park'

the best improved Peter Pan type we have found yet, with very compact growth, shorter, more robust stalks, and darker blue, more heavily textured flowers than seen on other plants sold as 'Peter Pan.' Foliage is dark green, stalks are reliably compact.

Agave attenuata 'Nova'

Succulent rosette, up to 2 feet in diameter (60 cm).

Succulent rosettes of broad soft gray leaves. Similar to *A. attenuata* but wider & bluer. Sun/Shade. Drought tolerant. 3-4' x 3-4'. Hardy to 28F. [*A. 'Boutin Blue'*, *A. 'Blue Boy'*]

Agave 'Cornelius'

18" tall x 2.5' wide, rarely-suckering clump of unusually thick, wavy blue-green leaves are highlighted by a 2" wide golden border.

Agave geminiflora	Twin-flowered Agave - Succulent to 2-3 tall and wide w/ narrow green leaves lacking any spines on leaf edge. Cool Sun/Light Shade. Drought tolerant. 25-30 degrees F [Agave angustissima]
Agave parryi var. truncata	Succulent with 2' tall by 4' wide rosettes of short blue-gray leaves w/ reddish-brown spines. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 15 degrees F.
Agave shawii	Shaw's Agave - Rosette forming succulent to 2-3' tall x spreading. Full sun/light shade (required in desert). Drought tolerant. Hardy to 25 degrees F.
Agave victoria-reginae	Queen Victoria Agave - Rosette forming succulent to 1" tall by 18" wide with rigid white patterned leaves. Full sun/light shade. Low water needs. Hardy to 10 degrees F.
Agonis flexouosa 'After Dark'	After Dark Peppermint Tree - Evergreen tree 18' tall w/peppermint smelling burgundy foliage & white flowers in spring/summer. Full sun. Moderate watering needs. Hardy to 25 F.
Allium senescens	Nodding flower buds arise to umbels of 2" lavender flowers in midsummer. Attracts butterflies. The bright green, flat foliage that surrounds these gorgeous blooms forms a neat 1 foot tall mound Excellent for edging or the border foreground; grows only 8-10 inches tall. Quick to clump-up, easy and permanent, Allium senescens blooms beautifully even in the worst of droughts.
Aloe ciliaris	Climbing Aloe - Succulent vine that can grow with support to 12' high. Scarlet-red inflorescence year-round. Sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 30-32 degrees F.
Aloe 'Johnsons Hybrid	Small succulent to just under 1' tall with narrow upright green leaves and orange flowers. Full sun-light shade. Occasional irrigation. Hardy to 20F.
Aloe saponaria	12in, colony of offsets to 12ft or more; rapid growth Leaves are thick points with coarsely-toothed margins, dark green with distinctive white spots, foliage sometimes has reddish tinge, teeth are brown. Flower stalks 1/2 to 3ft tall, clusters of tubular coral-colored flowers, bloom in spring through early summer (first bloom is best)
Alstroemeria	Peruvian lily assorted
Amaryllis belladonna	Naked Lady - Deciduous bulb with dark pink, pale-pink or white flowers in late summer. Winter foliage to 2-3' tall. Full sun. Low water needs. 25-30 degrees F.
Anamanthele lessoniana	Graceful, ever green orange and green grass, 2-3'.
Anigozanthos 'Royal Cheer'	a smaller grower, to about 2', with wide, rather lax, dark green leaves, and wildly colorful, felty red stalks and bud bases that contrast with large, very blue green flowers. This one is fussy about drainage (must be good), soil (must be light and mineral), watering (must be adequate but infrequent, especially in summer), and climate (must be Mediterranean in nature, with not-too-stressful summer heat).

Anthriscus sylvestris 'Ravenswing'	Biennial or Perennial: Nice ferny foliage turns purple-black & adds great interest to the garden. A nice meadow plant that is vigorous & self-sows if allowed to seed. Blooms: spring-summer. Flat flower heads are white with pink bracts. Clump forming growth habit: 1.5' x 2', flowers to 3'. Exposure: sun/part shade. Water: moderate. USDA Z4-10.
Aquilegia	Columbine assorted
Arbutus 'Marina' (bush)	50'+bush Glossy dark green leaves. Pink&white fls. red fruits.
Arbutus 'Marina' (std.)	50'+tree Glossy dark green leaves. Pink&white fls. red fruits.
Arctostaphylos 'Emerald Carpet'	When grown well this manzanita forms a wonderful, dense, green groundcover around 1 ft. tall by 6 ft. wide. To thrive this shrub demands good drainage. In hot inland areas a little afternoon shade is required along with occasional deep summer waterings.
Aristea major	Iris-like leaves; bright blue fls. on 5-6' stems, summer.
Artemesia 'Huntington'	To 3'tallx4'wide. Finely cut white leaves with small yellow flowers.
Azalea 'Felder's White'	White. Medium single. Upright , fast grower. Blooms March-April
Azalea 'Pride of Dorking'	Deep carmine red. Medium Single. Upright grower. Blooms April-May
Babiana stricta	Baboon Flower - Bulb with pleated leaves about 6" tall with blue violet flowers in spring. Drought tolerant (summer dormant. Hardy to below 15 degrees F.
Bambusa multiplex 'Alphonse Karr'	Alphonse Karr Bamboo - Clumping bamboo with green striped yellow culms to 25' tall by 1 1/2" wide. Sun/Light Shade. Give occasional irrigation. Hardy to 12 degrees F.
Banksia grandis	The dark green toothed leaves are leathery & grow to 12" long. Growing to 30' tall, the shrub looks great even out of bloom. The large, yellow cylindrical flowers get to be 12" long
Begonia luxurians	Palm Leaf Begonia - A shrubby begonia growing to 4-8 feet tall with large compound leaves. Bright shade. Protect from temp <30 degrees F. Ample water.
Berberis lomariifolia	Chinese Holly - Evergreen shrub. Part sun. Regular watering. Yellow flower in winter-early spring. 6-10' x3-5'. 20-25 degrees F. [Mahonia lomariifolia]
Berberis thunbergii 'Rose Glow'	Compact, red-tinged, with pink-variegated new growth.
Beschorneria	clumps eventually 3-4' wide. Flowers early summer.
Beschorneria septentrionalis	The glossy, evergreen rosette (no spines) makes an attractive clump to 3' wide. After it is well established, you will enjoy the 5' tall, glossy, red flower spikes that are adorned with lovely reddish bells with green tips in March/April
Bilbergia windii	ong straplike leaves that form a loose rosette. Moreover, down the edges of each leaf are fine spines. Pink bracts cover the upper part of the arching inflorescence. Also, blue, green, and yellow flowers hang loosely from the ends of this flower spike, To 3'+. Dark green fronds, creeping rhizomes. Evergreen.

Bocconia frutescens	Tree Poppy - Large shrub to 12-18 ft. Unusual, large gray green foliage. The small flowers are not showy. Full sun. Low irrigation requirements.
Bougainvillea 'San Diego Red'	Evergreen vine with magenta red bracts in summer-fall. Full sun. Low water needs. 20-25 degrees F.

Brickellia californica	a common shrub of dry, rocky slopes & washes in our chaparral & coastal-sage-scrub areas below 8000 ft. Base branching to 4' tall & wide, with triangular gray-green leaves, it blooms Aug. thru Oct. The yellowish-green flowers are pendulous & held in little bunches and very fragrant. Deciduous. Water once a week or so the first year, very little thereafter. Tolerates sand & clay.
Buxus sempervirens	English Boxwood. Hardy perennial evergreen with small, glossy oval leaves. Pale green, petalless flowers appear in spring. If left to its own devices, Box can grow to 15 ft
Buxus sempervirens 'Variegated'	Slow, compact English box wood. Cream variegation.
Calandrinia grandiflora	The fleshy leaves are gray-green up to 8 inches long and the plant will reach about 36 inches tall. Needs a well-drained soil and full sun to partial shade
Callicarpa bodinieri var. giralkii 'Profusion'	It is the tiny fruit that ripen in October that make this a stand-out among ornamental shrubs. When the deciduous leaves have fallen, the beautyberry fruits cling to the branches in gorgeous clusters. It reaches on average six or eight feet tall
Callistemon viminalis 'Little John'	Bottle brush; dwarf, 3'round, dense. Red flowers.
Calycanthus occidentalis	Spice bush; 8' native with large leaves, dark red flowers.
Camelia sasanqua 'Pink'	Sasanqua's have mature heights that range from about 4-15 ft
Campanula portenschlagiana	Dalmatian Bellflower - Evergreen groundcover. Part sun. Moderate water needs. Blue flower in summer. 8 in.x24 in. Hardy to <15 degrees F.
Canna 'Phasion'	Tall stems are crowned by large bright orange flower heads, summer to fall. Exotic foliage adds interest; emerging bright burgundy leaves mature with splendid stripes of red, pink, yellow and green in varying patterns. Perennial. Full sun. Fast-growing erect stalks to 5 to 5½ feet tall.
Cannomis	Bell Reed - Grass-like plant to 7' tall w/red culm sheaths & drooping hairlike leaves. Full/part sun in well drained acidic soil. Regular water. To mid 20'sF?
Cantua buxifolia 'Yellow'	Cantua buxifolia displays hundreds of 3" pendant long yellow flaring tubular flowers turning white at the ends. With rich soil, a bit of shade and adequate water, it will continue to bloom sporadically all Summer. Fast growing and happily evergreen with attractive glossy bright green foliage, it'll reach 6' to 8' tall within a year. Do grow Cantua in rich soil and regular water with some shade in the afternoon.
Carex elegantissima 'Variegata'	Golden-Edged Sedge - Grass-like plant w/neat tight clumps to 1 foot tall w/ thin pale yellow variegated leaves. Give regular water. Full sun, light shade hardy to 10-15 F.
Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'	Variegated Japanese Sedge - Clumping, evergreen sedge, w/ variegated leaves. Likes shady, moist areas. 1-2 ft tall. 0-20 degrees F. Also known as C. morrowii 'Aurea-variegata'
Carex phyllocephala 'Sparkler'	Sparkler Palm Sedge - Evergreen grass-like plant to 1-2' tall with variegated foliage. Light shade. Regular to abundant irrigation. Hardy to 10 degrees
Caryopteris x clandonensis 'Dark Knight'	Blue spiraea; bushy, 3'; aromatic leaves; deep blue flowers.

Cassia bicapsularis 'Worley's Butter Creme'	8', spreading. Bright divided leaves, yellow-cream flowers
Cassia tomentosa	Shrub or small tree. Golden flowers in summer and fall.
Ceanothus 'Concha'	Wild Lilac - Evergreen shrub to 8' tall x 10' wide. Dark blue flower in spring. Plant in full sun. Low water needs. Hardy to 10 degrees F.
Ceanothus 'Joan Mirov'	CA lilac. Dark blue flowers coat 3'h/10'w shrub.
Ceanothus 'Ray Hartman'	Wild Lilac - Evergreen shrub to 16- 20' by as wide with blue flower winter-spring. Full sun. Low water needs. Hardy to 5-10 degrees F.
Cedrus atlantica 'Glauca Pendula'	15 to 30 feet. Powdery steel-blue needles borne in whorls, drooping vertical branches; no well-defined central leader, Easily trained as espalier
Ceratostigma griffithii	To 2', shrubby; blue-green leaves, sky-blue flowers.
Ceratostigma minus	2-3', vase-shaped; blue-green leaves, bright blue flowers.
Ceratostigma willmottianum	Chinese plumbago; 2-4'h/w, dark blue flowers.
Ceratostigma willmottianum 'My Love'	1'x1' This low-growing form sports stunning golden-yellow foliage, contrasting marvelously with the brilliant blue flowers. A great plant for containers in shaded or partial-shaded sites.
Cestrum elegans 'Dark Red'	an evergreen shrub that will reach 6-8 feet tall with a 4-5 feet spread in nature. It is a showy plant that does well in pots or tubs. Red cestrum has purplish-red tubular flowers, that are about 1 inch long and about 3/8 inch wide
Cestrum 'Newelii'	Red Cestrum - Upright growing shrub to 6-8' tall with red flowers year-round. Full sun. Regular water. Hardy to 15 F.
Cheilanthes lindheimeri	desert fern 1'x1'
Chilopsis linearis 'Purple Splendour'	Desert willow. Rounded. Large shaded purplish pink flowers
Chusquea pittieri	To 30'+. Arching stems, many drooping branch lets, 2" lvs.
Cistus 'Victor Reiter'	To 5'h. Erect. Bright salmon-pink flowers have white centers.
Citrus - Lemon 'Meyer' (dwarf)	Dwarf citrus trees bear fragrant flowers followed by tasty fruit! The Improved Meyer Lemon has fruits year-around. (Move plants indoors for winter in Northern zones.)
Clivia (different colors)	Evergreen perennial. Shade. Moderate waterings. Pale orange flowers in winter-spring. 2'x2'. 30-32 degrees F.
Coleonema album	White Breath of Heaven - Evergreen shrub to 5' tall and wide with white flowers in winter-spring. Full sun/Part shade. Regular watering. 25-30 degrees F.
Coleonema pulchellum 'Sunset Gold'	Golden Breath of Heaven - Evergreen shrub to 2' x 6' w/chartreuse colored foliage pale pink flowers in winter-spring. Full/part sun. Moderate/ low water. 20-25 degrees F.
Colletia paradoxa rhamnaceae	Anchor Plant - Slow growing leafless shrub 6-9' tall w/spiny triangular stems & white flowers in fall. Full sun. Well drained soil. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 20F.
Colocasia esculenta 'Illustris'	Imperial Taro - Dramatic perennial 3-6' tall with dark purple leaves w/ green veins.Hardy to mid 20's. Evergreen in frost free areas. Regular water.Perfect for ponds.
Convolvulus cneorum	Bush Morning Glory - Evergreen shrub. Sun/Light shade. Low water needs. White flowers in spring-fall. 2-4' tall and wide. 15-20 degrees F.

Coprosma 'Evening Glow'	Evening Glow Mirror Bush - Evergreen shrub to 4-5' tall w/foilage that is yellow, orange, red & green. Plant in full (coastal) to part sun. Water regularly. Hardy to 20-25F.
Coprosma 'Fireburst'	The variegated dark green leaves are egg-shaped to obovate and have relatively broad orange margins, turning orange/red on older leaves. During autumn the leaves change into a dramatic red with green. These colours stay during winter and make 'Fireburst' a striking plant!
Coprosma 'Roy's Red'	Smaller narrow reddish brown foliage, this small shrub is useful for topiary, bonsai or contrasting foliage for containers. Can tolerate temps in the 20's. 2'.
Cordyline (variegated)	Pink Striped Grass Palm - Tree-like plant to 25 ft. tall with pink striped lvs & large panicles of white fragrant flwrs. Sun/light shade. Low to regular h20. Hardy to 15 F
Cordyline australis 'Pink Stripe'	Pink Striped Grass Palm - Tree-like plant to 25 ft. tall with pink striped lvs & large panicles of white fragrant flwrs. Sun/light shade. Low to regular h20. Hardy to 15 F
Cordyline australis 'Red Sensation'	A focus plant with long, broad leaves colored deep red. Upright habit to 25 ft. tall. Prefers full sun and is frost hardy to -10 F.
Cordyline stricta 'Soledad Purple'	narrow evergreen shrub to 6-10', grown for its tropical look and thin, gracile, relaxed grassy dark green foliage. In this selection the entire underside of the leaf has purplish tones. It bears a nice show of light blue to lavender blue flowers in spike-like, often drooping clusters spring and early summer, followed by blue black fruits.Coastal sun otherwise dappled or full shade. Regular water, can't withstand multiple hard freezes.
Coreopsis gigantea	Thick trunk to 4'+ topped by lacy green leaves, yellow daisies.
Correa pulchella	Pink Australian Fuchsia - Evergreen shrub to 3' tall by 5' wide with light pink flowers in winter-spring. Full/part Sun. Occasional water. Hardy to 20 F.
Correa 'Wyn's Wonder'	Variegated Australian Fuchsia - Evergreen shrub 2-3' tall w/olive green leaves w/creamy variegation & pin-red flwrs fall-winter. Full sun/ light shade. Well drained s Hardy to 20-25F
Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple'	Purple Smoke Tree - Deciduous shrub to 12-15'+ tall & as wide w/round dark burgundy lvs & pink flwrs in spring. Sun/Light shade. Good drainage. Drought tolerant. Hardy.
Cotula squalida	Brass Buttons is a semi-treadable half-inch-tall groundcover and spreads aggressively with runners over the surface or just underground. At its bushiest it reaches a scant one or two inches of height. Its feathery dull-green leaves look like the tiniest possible ferns. It isn't really a fern, but is a diminutive relative of the sunflower. It likes part shade but does well in sun.
Cotyledon orbiculata	Succulent to 2' tall w/flat white-gray leaves & pale orange flowers in summer. Full sun (coastal)/light shade Low water. Hardy to 25-30 degrees F

Crassula perfoliata	Its leaves are gray or gray-green, and they may be up to 8 inches long, though usually less than this. Plants may grow to 2 feet or more in height, but the stems often sprawl to the side if they get too long. Light shade to full sun, generally needs full sun part of the day to bloom and usually flowers in July and August. Most species of Crassula have flowers in the white-to-pink range
Corokia cotoneaster 'Little Prince'	Evergreen shrub. Sun/Light shade. Moderate water. Yellow flowers in spring. 4'x3'. Hardy to <15 degrees F.
Cuphea 'Minnie Mouse'	Hundreds of flowers are borne simultaneously on a dense, multi-branching plant, 3' tall & wide. Rich, ruby-brown "mousketeer ears" sit erect above the face of the long, tubular, bright, coral-red flowers, which dangle all along 8"-10", arching stems. Filtered-shade, bright shade to part sun & rich soil is best.
Cuphea 'Strybing Sunset'	Covered in blooms most of the year, each slender orange bloom fades from red to a yellow tip. It has a bat face & dark brown bat ears. Shrub gets to be 4' tall & wide (maybe more) but can be kept smaller by trimming back.
Cussonia paniculata?	Evergreen small tree. Full sun. Moderate water needs. Needs good drainage. Yellow flowers. 10-15' tall. 20-25 degrees F.
Cussonia spicata	The fun shape it creates is rather like a palm tree with the foliage popping out of the top of a single, thick, corky-barked trunk. The evergreen foliage is cool looking - smooth, bluish-green & deeply lobed. The light colored corky bark is interesting & attractive. Thick, candle-like flower spikes emerge from the central foliage tuft in late Spring to early Summer. I've only seen them reach a height of 10'-12' but they reach 30' in their native environment, eventually becoming a multi-stemmed, multi-branched tree. Growth rate depends on how much water you provide & they much prefer & regular watering.
Cypella plumbea	Blue flower related to Iris
Cyperus papyrus 'King Tut'	Small form of Papyrus forms clumps to 2-3' tall . Great for small ponds. Full sun/part shade (more shade tolerant than species). Hardy to 20-25 F.
Cyrtomium falcatum var. maritimum	this choice fern for the woodland rock garden makes a small clump, eventually reaching 6" tall x 15" wide. The very thick, glossy green leaves make this an eye-catching specimen.
Dahlia	Dahlia assorted
Danae racemosa??	3' shrub, elegant, graceful form and shiny evergreen foliage, creating a year-round standout in the shade garden. Leaves are narrow and dark green; the white racemes of bloom are not showy, but lead to 1/2" cherry-tomato red fruits that decorate the shrub in fall and early winter.
Daphne caucasica	It has fine, gray green foliage and a rounded, mounding habit. The small white flowers are highly fragrant and bloom sporadically throughout the summer.
Dasylyrion longissimum	Mexican Grass Tree - Evergreen yucca-like succulent to 6+ ft w/long narrow leaves & tall stalks of white flwrs in summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to <15 F.

Dianthus 'Chomley Farran'	The double flowers are wonderfully striped with pink & lavender. And they are fragrant too! Each flower is about 1-1/2" wide & grows on 1' long stems. The foliage forms a nice sturdy mound of blue-green foliage that is nice looking by itself.
Dichondra argentea	Silver Dichondra - Groundcover w/cascading ground hugging silvery foliage. Semi-deciduous in winter. Plant in full sun to light shade. Water occasionally. Hardy to 20 F
Dichroa febrifuga	Blue Evergreen Hydrangea - Evergreen shrub. Part sun/Light shade. Water regularly. Blue & white flowers in spring-summer. 6'x5'. 20-25 degrees F.
Doryanthes palmeri	Spear Lily - Evergreen succulent w/long pleated lvs to 8' tall. Red flower on stalks rising above foliage in summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. 25-30 degrees F.
Drepanostachyum 'Marcia Donahue'	This popular bamboo is a very cold hardy plant that thrives in moist, sheltered, shady conditions. Will not stand full sun for long, and does not like wind, (especially hot dry winds) but in a sheltered shady spot grows well, into a 9-12' plant with masses of small drooping leaves. Can be trimmed for a good indoor bamboo plant.
Echium candicans	Pride of Madeira - Evergreen shrub to 4-6' tall and wide. Bluish-purple flowers in early summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 25 degrees F. [Echium fastuosum]
Echium candicans 'Select Blue'	Pride of Madeira - Evergreen shrub 3-6' tall by 4-8' wide. Blue flowers in early summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 25 degrees F. [E. fastuosum 'Select Blue']
Echeveria (wavy edge) Echeveria imbricata	This succulent has small, tight rosettes of grey-green leaves that create offsets freely. It stays 4 to 5 inches tall. Branched clusters of red and yellow flowers bloom in the spring and early summer. It prefers full sun and is drought tolerant. It is hardy to about 20 degrees F.
Elaeagnus pungens 'Maculata'	This mounding shrub has long arching sprays of foliage. Fragrant flowers are not showy and hardly seen but their presence is made known in September and October with a powerfully sweet fragrance. It can reach 15 feet high and across in extreme age but hand pruning will keep it to a more manageable 8 by 8 feet.
Epidendrum (orange)	Semi-hardy or chid; leafy stems, bright purplish pink flowers
Euphorbia amygdaloides var. robbiae	Round dark green leaves on stems to 1', slowly spreading.
Euphorbia characias wulfenii	4'; narrow leaves, huge chartreuse flower clusters.
Euphorbia characias wulfenii 'Tasmanian Tiger'	Variiegated Spurge - Perennial 3' tall w/variegated foliage & flower bracts in summer. Full sun/Light shade. Hardy to 0 to 10 degrees F.
Euphorbia 'Jade Dragon'	The pointed, blue-green leaves create a compact, deer proof assemblage that's infused with reddish purple tinges. This robust, tidy-looking Milkwort shoulders summer blooming chartreuse flower heads nearly one foot across.
Euphorbia lambii	Tree Euphorbia - Evergreen tree. Full sun. Low water needs. Chartreuse flowers in spring. 6-10' tall. 25-30 degrees F.

Euphorbia rigida	The foliage of Euphorbia rigida is a beautiful blue-green & consists of pointy leaves spiraling around upright stems. The flowers, which occur in late Winter through Spring, are a cheerful lime green that contrasts nicely with the blue foliage. The plant grows to about 2' tall & 3' wide. After the flowers are spent prune out old stems to make way for the new growth.
Euphorbia tirucalli	Pencil tree can reach a height of 20-30ft with a 6-10ft spread. The main trunk and branches are woody and brownish, but the younger branches are green and cylindrical, looking like so many pencils.
Fargesia fungosa (Borinda)	18' tall and 1" diameter these bamboo culms turn a burgundy-red when exposed to morning sun. It has larger leaves than most of our <i>Fargesias</i> and will prosper in milder parts of the Pacific Northwest and California if planted in partial shade.
Fuchsia 'Fanfare'	Scandent shrub. Long tubes coral, vivid or orange petals.
Fuchsia 'Firecracker'	Shrub: This selection has everything! Creamy-white variegated leaves-new growth has a striking pink tinge. Vibrant long-tubed orange-red blooms spring-summer. Attracts hummingbirds. Border & pot plant. Tolerates coast & gophers. Deciduous. Upright, shrub-like growth similar to 'Gartenmeister'. 18-24" x 16-20". Part shade. Water: moderate. USDA Z9.
Fuchsia 'Nettala'	With support it can get tall (6-7'), though a cold winter will take it down in size again. Pinching may keep it more compact. The petals are quite unique by having a very elongated base, enabling you to see right through the center of the flower. The color is killclassic Fuchsia.
Furcraea variegata	Looking much like an agave in shape and form but having slightly more fleshy leaves. Each leaf is bright creamy white generously streaked with apple green.
Gaura lindheimeri 'Passionate Rainbow'	Perennial: Drought, deer & heat tolerant. Excellent border & pot plant. Rose pink flowers are formed at tips & on side branches-not on long wands like others. Pretty green foliage w/white edges have rose-pink colored new growth. Good cut flower. Attracts butterflies. Blooms: spring-fall. Compact form: 20-30" x 24-30". Full sun. Water: moderate. USDA Z4. PPAF
Ginkgo biloba 'Autumn Gold'	This superb shade tree is a male non-fruiting selection. Unique fan-shaped foliage turns golden yellow in fall. Its symmetrical upright branching form becomes broad with age. Deciduous. Full sun. Slow-growing to 35 to 50 feet high, equal width. Grafted.
Grevillea 'Robyn Gordon' (staked)	Grevillea Robyn Gordon can attain a height and width of 8-10 feet and maybe more. Cold becomes a problem when temperatures dip into the low teens. Some people react to the hairs on the leaves with rash.
Grevillea rosmarinifolia 'Scarlet Sprite'	Evergreen shrub to 5' tall x 8' wide w/green pine needle lvs & rose pink flowers late winter to spring. Full sun. Drought tolerant. 20-25 degrees F.
Grevillea 'Ruby Clusters'	6'+, bushy; narrow 3" leaves, dark red flowers.
Hebe 'Patty's Purple'	3' t. Compact sel. Rose-lavender flowers, dark green leaves.
Hebe pimeleoides 'Quicksilver'	Low, dense, wiry shrublet; silver grey leaves.

Hebe variegata	Shrub: A striking evergreen perennial good for containers & borders. Glossy gray-green foliage has broad cream margins. Nice cut flower, attracts butterflies & tolerates coastal conditions. Size: 2.5-4' x 2-4'. Bloom time: summer-fall. Bloom color: reddish purple. Exposure: sun/light shade. Water: moderate. USDA Z9-11.
Heliotrope arborescens 'Album'	Perennial Shrub: Deer resistant. An unusual white form with very fragrant, vanilla-scented clusters of flowers. Good in borders, beds, window boxes & pots. Attracts butterflies. Blooms: summer-fall. Color: white (sometimes will have a lavender tinge). Height: 2 feet (taller in mild climates). Exposure: sun. Water: moderate (avoid overwatering). USDA Z10.
Heliotrope 'Marine'	compact plant 8-10 inches tall. The flowerheads sprawl 8-12 inches across, packed with deep purple blooms and framed in strongly-veined, bright green foliage right down to the ground. Best in full sun, where it blooms all summer.
Helleborus argutifolius	Perennial: Evergreen. Drought and clay tolerant. Deer resistant. Good cut flower, woodland, rock garden and border plant. Produces clusters of nodding cup-shaped flowers. Self seeds. Bloom time: winter-spring. Bloom color: apple green. Height: 1-2 feet. Exposure: part shade/shade. Water: moderate/dry. USDA Z7.

Heuchera hybrid 'Purple & Silver'	Alum root; large purple-tinged leaves, white flowers.
Himalayacalamus hookerianus 'Baby Blue'	Dwarf Blue Bamboo - Beautiful clumping bamboo to 5-7' tall with up to 1/4" culms with blue dusting and dark green leaves. Part sun/ light shade. Hardy to 15 F.
Homalocladium platycladum	Ribbon Bush, Tapeworm Plant - Upright growing shrub to 4-8' with flat leafless stems & small green flowers in fall-winter. Full sun/shade. Regular to little water. Hardy to 25 F.
Hydrangea (double pink flowers) Hydrangea macrophylla 'Kardinal'	This can grow as a red, burgundy or purple lacecap and is very pH sensitive. It is most popular as a red but has other colors so vibrant you won't be disappointed regardless of soil type. This plant blooms mid-season on strong sturdy stems and the large dark green leaves only add to its beauty. 5'x5'
Hydrangea macrophylla 'Blauer Prinz'	This medium sized plant blooms a beautiful cornflower-blue with a touch of purple in high acid soil. Aluminum sulphate can be added when a young plant to keep it from turning rose colored. A late-flowering blue hydrangea with dark green leaves that endure into the fall. The flower heads stay in perfect condition turning to green, red, or purple autumnal tints.

Iris unguicularis	Some years this begins blooming in late autumn and then repeats in the late winter. The flowers bloom within 12" long grass-like evergreen foliage, perhaps seeking its protection. Not showy from a distance but a breath of fresh air at a difficult time of year. We treasure the lavender-blue flowers with yellow blazes on their falls.
Isopogon anemonifolius	a small to medium shrub from about 2-6' in height by a similar width. The leaves are divided into many small linear segments. The yellow flowers occur in late spring and early summer, conspicuously displayed on the ends of the branches. The flower clusters are around 1" in diameter and are followed by the spherical (barrel-shaped) seed pods which remain on the plant for an indefinite period.
Jacaranda mimosifolia (low branched)	Jacaranda - Semi-evergreen tree to 40' tall by 30' wide with lavender blue flowers in late spring-summer. Full sun. Occasional watering. 25-30 degrees F.

Jordaaniella cuprea Jovellana punctata	Jovellana flowers look like really pretty colored open fish mouths. The flowers are white, but have spots & a yellow blotch on the bottom lip. Justicia rizzinii	Firecracker Flower - A compact shrub to 3-4' tall with small leaves & tubular red and yellow flowers in winter. Full to part sun. Medium H2O. Hardy to 27F
Kniphofia 'Shining Sceptre'	Red Hot Poker - Perennial with 3-4' stalks of orange and yellow flower heads that bloom early to mid summer. Medium water needs. Full sun. Hardy to 0-10 F.
Lagerstroemia (lavender flowers)	Delicate paper thin petals; beautiful large blooms in white, pink, red, or purple; lustrous green leaves forming a thick canopy of foliage; smooth, exfoliating bark; one of the favorite plants in a Southern garden; this is the Crapemyrtle.
Lagerstroemia (magenta red flowers)	Delicate paper thin petals; beautiful large blooms in white, pink, red, or purple; lustrous green leaves forming a thick canopy of foliage; smooth, exfoliating bark; one of the favorite plants in a Southern garden; this is the Crapemyrtle.
Lagerstroemia 'Red Rocket'	Delicate paper thin petals; beautiful large blooms in white, pink, red, or purple; lustrous green leaves forming a thick canopy of foliage; smooth, exfoliating bark; one of the favorite plants in a Southern garden; this is the Crapemyrtle.
Lampranthus aureus	Lampranthus aureus 'Orange Form' grows more upright rather than sprawling, so it makes a polite partner when mixing with other plants in the garden.
Lantana 'Citrus Blend'	Brilliant tones of red, orange and yellow produce a vibrant display of color; heat and drought tolerant with a light, sweet fragrance. 2-3'high x2-3'wide
Lantana 'Radiation'	Shrub: Evergreen and ever blooming in frost-free areas. Deer and gopher resistant. Fire retardant. Tolerant of light drought. Good border, ground cover, container and hanging basket plant. Attracts hummingbirds. Bloom color: bicolored orange and red blooms. Size: 3-5' x 3-5'. Exposure: sun. Water: moderate. USDA Z9.
Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote'?	Under 1'; bright grey leaves, dark purple flowers.
Leptospermum 'Dark Shadow'	Fast growing shrub or small tree to 15' tall by 20' wide w/ red tinged foliage & white flwrs in summer. Low water needs. Full Sun. Hardy to 20-25 F.
Leptospermum scoparium 'Ruby Glow'	Tea tree. 3/4" double deep red flowers, purple-tinged leaves.
Leptospermum turbinatum 'Flat Rock'	To 6'. Glossy dark green leaves, bright white flowers spring.

Leucadendron discolor 'Pom Pom'	A showy, drought-tolerant shrub that's an ideal short screening plant. It features blue-gray, oval-shaped leaves that often take on purple tones during cool weather. In spring, male plants produce cone-shaped clusters of red and yellow flowers that can be cut and used indoors.
Leucadendron 'Jester'	Showy, rich red bracts sit atop branches of variegated foliage in late winter into spring. Foliage sports colors of bright pink, cream and green. Although a sport of 'Safari Sunset' this selection is less vigorous but matures to the same size of 4-5 feet tall and wide.
Leucadendron 'Yeati' Leucospermum cordifolium	To 8'+, bushy, up right; Narrow lt. green leaves, yellow bracts. A rounded spreading shrub up to 6' in diameter and about 4' high, with a single main stem and horizontally spreading stems, hard green leaves and from the middle of July to the end of November, groups of 1 to 3 large red and orange groups of small flowers are borne at the end on the stem.
Leucospermum cordifolium 'Don's Red'	Compact shrub to 4 ft' tall and wide, red blossom clusters are 4" across with individual tube shaped flowers that curve gracefully outward then inward again.
Leucospermum 'Red Sunset' Leucospermum 'Spider'??	red flower Spider Pincushion - Shrub 6-8' tall x 10' wide. Winter flowers salmon & golden yellow w/red tipped stamens. Full Sun, good drainage. Hardy to 28 F.
Leucospermum 'Tango' Libertia peregrinans	red/orange flower Orange Libertia - Perennial. Sun/Light Shade. Moderate water needs. White flower in spring. 2' tall. 15-20 degrees F.
Limonium perezii	Sea Lavender, Statice - Perennial to 3'x3' with purple & white flowers in summer. Full sun. Low water needs. Hardy to 25-30 degrees F.
Lonicera nitida 'Baggesen's Gold' Lonicera nitida 'Red Tip'	Bushy, spreading. Small leaves, bright yellow new growth. Dense, hedging bush. Deep green leaves, burgundy new growth.
Lophomyrtus x ralphii 'Sundae'	Upright shrub to 8-12' w/small rounded puckered lvs with cream margins and white flwrs. Plant in full sun. Regular irrigation. Hardy to 15-20 F.
Lophomyrtus x ralphii 'Kathryn'	An evergreen shrub from New Zealand with distinctive deep glossy red-purple colouring. Leaves turn reddish purple to coppery brown in the winter. Forms a bushy shrub to about 6' high with a spread of 4'. Makes an excellent plant for cut foliage. Hardy to about minus 7 degrees. Plant in light shade to full sun, in a well-drained soil that does not dry out too much in the summer. White flowers are produced in the summer.
Loropetalum chinense	Fringe Flower - Evergreen shrub 4-8' tall by 6-8' wide. Dark green leaves. White flowers in spring. Cool sun/part shade. Occasional watering. Hardy to 10-15 F.

Melaleuca quinquenervia (std.)	Punk Tree - Evergreen tree. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Yellow-white flowers in summer-fall. 40' tall. 20-25 degrees F.
Melianthus major	Honey Bush - Evergreen shrub to 12' tall w/large gray serrated lvs & maroon flowers in winter-spring. Sun/Light Shade. Occasional watering. 15-20 degrees F.
Muhlenbergia dumosa	Bamboo Muhly - Evergreen grass 4-6' tall w/fine light green leaves and pale purple flowers in fall-winter. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 15-20 degrees F.
Muhlenbergia rigens	Deer Grass - Evergreen grass to 4-5' tall w/thin spikes of silver-gray flowers in summer. Sun/Part shade. Drought tolerant. Hardy to <15 degrees F.
Musella lasiocarpa	Golden Lotus Banana - Unusual perennial to 3-4 ft tall with gray-green broad lance shaped foliage and large yellow flowers. Plant in sun/ shade. Hardy to at least 10 F.
Myrica californica	Pacific Wax Myrtle - Native evergreen shrub to 30' tall by 20' wide. Full/part sun. Drought tolerant. Seaside and wind tolerant. Hardy to <15 F.
Nandina domestica 'Umpqua Princess'	This is an upright shrub with evergreen leaves that change to reddish-purple in fall. It reaches a mature height of between three and five feet. Leaves are pinate to 3-pinate with lance-shaped leaflets. Bears conical panicles to 16 inches long, of small star-shaped, white flowers with large, yellow anthers. Red berry-like clusters are persistent through winter,
Nandina domestica filamentosa	Thread-leaf Nandina - Evergreen shrub to 1-2' w/ very fine textured foliage . Sun/Shade. Water occasionally. Whitish flowers spring-summer. Hardy to 10-15 degrees F.
Nerium oleander 'Hardy Red'	Hardy Red Oleander for the hardy tropical enthusiast or container gardeners. Evergreen foliage to single digit temperatures, will rebound from the roots to 6' and very good flowering.

Nerium oleander 'Sister Agnes'	Nerium oleander is an evergreen shrub reaching 6 to 12 feet in height and spread, occasionally 20 feet. Not cold hardy, so subject to freeze damage. The leaves are dark green throughout the seasons. Flowers bloom in summer to early fall; each flower is 1 1/2 inches in diameter
Opuntia 'Santa Rita'	flat round pads, to 8in long; new growth is reddish or purple, mature pads off-green; in fall all pads may be purple; areoles evenly spaced about 1in apart; spines usually absent on face but found along perimeter of pads; numerous yellow, fuzzy-looking glochids are dangerous. Orangy yellow flowers are 3.5in diameter along edge of pads
Ornithogolum dubium	Snake Flower - Spring blooming bulb with stalks of star-shaped orange flowers that are fragrant and long lasting. Full sun. Regular Water. Hardy to USDA Zone 7.
Orphium frutescens	South African shrublet bursts into bloom starting in May & continues all the way to August. Flower buds are twisted in the bud stage & then unfold into large & glossy, star-shaped, deep pink flowers. The fun foliage is a fresh green color, the narrow leaves are thick & both leathery & velvety & point upwards. Native to the South African coast, it thrives under coastal conditions (including salt spray). Thrives in the garden, too, needing only composty, well drained soil & regular water. Pinching the tips will encourage bushiness or plant in groups for best show. To 2' tall.
Osmanthus fragrans	Sweet Olive - Evergreen shrub. Cool Sun/Light shade. Water regularly. Fragrant white flowers in spring-summer. 10'x12'. 20-25 degrees F.
Osmanthus fragrans aurantiacus	Broadleaf evergreen shrub or small tree, 20-40 ft Sun to part shade, best in acidic, well-drained soil. Drought tolerant when established but needs some watering for best performance. Can be grown as a hedge or in a pot.
Osmanthus heterophyllus 'Purpureus'	Chinese holly; purple new foliage, fragrant white flowers
Osmanthus heterophyllus 'Illicifolius'	6-20'. Toothed holly-leaves. Fragrant white flowers.
Osmanthus heterophyllus 'Variegatus'	4-5't. Creamy-edged leaves. Fragrant flowers.
Otatea ssp. aztecorum	Mexican Weeping Bamboo - Vigorous clumping bamboo to 20' tall w/ arching culms & abundant narrow leaves. Moderately drought tolerant. Full sun/light shade. Hardy to 22 F.
Parthenocissus tricuspidata	Boston Ivy - Deciduous vine. Sun/Shade. Water regularly. Spreads to 16-25 feet. Hardy to <15 degrees F.
Pelargonium sidoides	Kalwerbossie Geranium - Tight 12" mounding shrub w/silver-gray foliage. Small clusters of dark burgundy flowers year round. Full sun in well-drained soils. Hardy to <25 F.
Pennisetum setaceum 'Rubrum'	Red Fountain Grass - Semi-evergreen grass (mild climates) with 5' tall dark burgundy foliage and flowers in the summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Root hardy to 20 F.
Phaedranassa	These beautiful bulbs are characterized by having leaves that are glossy green, greyish-green, or covered in a dusty bloom. The flowers are produced in an umbel, most species having large tubular pink or red flowers that are variously banded in green, with anywhere from five or six flowers to fourteen or fifteen to an umbel.

Philadelphus coronarius 'Aureus'	fountain-like, deciduous shrub with fragrant, white, late spring or early summer flowers. An old fashioned favorite, at home in the shrub border. Phyllica pubescens	Featherhead - Evergreen shrub to 5' tall. Dense foliage with golden hairs. Stems terminate w/golden plumose bracts. Excellent for arrangements. Hardy to 20-25F.
Phyllitis scolopendrium	Evergreen fern with creeping rhizomes. Fronds are strap-shaped, shiny, leathery, bright green, up to 16 inches or more long, usually with wavy margins. This fern enjoys a reasonable amount of light, as well as a moist, slightly acidic soil. 1-2'x1-2' high and wide.
Picea albertiana	Dwarf Alberta spruce is a naturally occurring dwarf form of the Alberta white spruce. It has dense, bright green foliage and grows in a miniature compact cone shape, rarely more than 10 ft tall, and usually stays around 3 ft tall. It grows no more than 1-3 in per year. The evergreen needles are about 0.5 in long, slender and curved. They are crowded together and packed all around the stems like little bottlebrushes.

Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Gold Star'	Height: 3-5' Bloom Color: white Foliage Color: green & gold variegated
Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Irene Patterson'	'Irene Paterson' is a slow-growing cultivar bearing white leaves spotted and mottled between the veins.
Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Marjorie'	10'+, compact; cream variegation.
Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Silver Magic'	Erect shrub; small leaves, grey with cream, pink margins.
Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Silver Sheen'	8'+. Small round grey-green leaves. Dark stems.
Plectranthus argenteus	Silver Plectranthus - Perennial (shrub) 2-3' t / 4-6' w. Soft gray lvs & pale violet flowers in summer to fall. Sun to shade(best) . Irrigate occasionally. Hardy to 25 F.
Plectranthus 'Blue Yonder' (PPAF)	Perennial w/soft green leaves edged white & spikes of sky blue flowers spring-fall. Full Sun/ light shade. Regular to occasional water. Hardy to 25F.
Plectranthus ecklonii	This one with violet flowers is best grown in partial shade. It is recommended for gardens where frost is not too severe. In colder climates it can be grown as a container house plant indoors. <i>P. ecklonii</i> is a fast growing pioneer shrub and very suited for shady gardens. It will flower profusely the first season after planting. Prune back hard after flowering during midwinter. Cape plumbago; deeper blue flowers.
Plumbago auriculata 'Purple Robe'	
Podocarpus henkelii	Long Leafed Yellowwood - Evergreen tree to 25-35' tall with drooping dark green foliage. Sun/Part shade. Regular watering. Hardy to 20 degrees F.
Podocarpus latifolius	Evergreen tree to 25-35' tall with drooping dark green foliage, leaves taper only toward tip. Sun/Part shade. Regular watering. Hardy to 20 degrees F.
Polypodium aureum	Rhizomes send up young fronds which look like a bishop's crook before they open out. The fronds can reach a height of 3-4 feet with a 2 foot spread. They are feathery, broad, smooth and have a bluish cast. There is a row of yellow or orange spore clusters on each side of the central vein. Rabbit's Foot Ferns grow quite vigorously. They thrive in the temperature range 65 to 75 degrees.
Protea 'Late Mink'	
Protea laurifolia 'White Owl'	is similar to <i>Protea neriifolia</i> but has a more westerly distribution. The leaves are grey to bluish green and short stalked with horny margins. White fuzzy flowers.
Protea 'Pink Ice'	Evergreen shrub. Sun/Part shade. Drought tolerant. Clear pink flowers year-round. 7'x6'. 25-30 degrees F.
Pulmonaria	A low growing perennial flower that often has long, variegated leaves that come in spots or splashes. The small funnel shaped flowers can be very vivid, with some changing color as they mature.
Puya alpestris	Sapphire Tower - Clumping bromeliad w/gray spiny margined foliage 3' tall w/blue-green flowers in spring to 4-5' tall. Full sun. Drought tolerant. 15-20 degrees F.

Puya venusta	This slow growing, stunning, terrestrial member of the Bromeliad family forms gorgeous, architectural, compact rosettes (12"-15" tall) of serrated, silvery white "pineapple" leaves. In late Winter through early Summer, the knock-your-socks-off deep purple blooms emerge from huge, red pine-cone like clusters atop red, stiff, upright stems to 40" tall. Like all Bromeliads, it is a prolific sucker and each sucker lasts for years before dying. Perfect companion plant for Aloes & Agaves. Can be grown in large containers & ½/2-barrels. Average to fairly rich well-drained soil. Said to be hardy to 20° F.
Pyrus calleryana	The Ornamental Pear is a deciduous narrow conical tree growing broader with age, thornless and produces no edible fruit. This selection profusely blooms in late winter to early spring, bringing the landscape some of the first splashes of color with its white flowers. Ornamental Pear leaves are slightly scalloped or toothed with a glossy, dark green color which turns to a more gold-orange or red-mahogany in late autumn. <i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Bradford' can grow to be 50 feet in height and 40 foot in width.
Ranunculus cortusifolius Rhamnus alaternus 'Variegatus' (staked columns)	Robust, to 2'+. Large round leaves, satiny yellow flower clusters. Variiegated Buckthorn - Evergreen shrub to 8-12' tall w/cream variegated leaves & greenish-yellow flowers in spring. Sun/Light Shade. Drought tolerant. 10-15 degrees F
Ribes sanguineum 'Inverness White'	Deciduous Native to CA, 5-12' tall. In spring it produces drooping clusters of white flowers followed by maplelike leaves. Little to moderate water.
Ribes sanguineum pink	Deciduous Native to CA, 5-12' tall. In spring it produces drooping clusters of pink flowers followed by maplelike leaves. Little to moderate water.
Ribes viburnifolium	Catalina Currant - Evergreen shrub. Sun/Light Shade. Drought tolerant. Rose-pink flowers in spring. 3-4'x4-6'. 15-20 degrees F.
Rhododendron 'Anna Rose Whitney'	A fast-growing rhodie compared to most, it can reach eight feet tall & six wide in ten years, so it needs "stretching" space & shouldn't be too crowded. Trusses hold up to twenty brilliantly rose-colored funnel-flowers with faint freckles on the upper petal inside each funnel. The individual trumpets can be five inches big, so in all, this adds up to one of the largest flower trusses, eight to eleven inches wide.
Rondeletia splendens	Rondeletia splendens, a compact bushy plant with clusters of red blooms at tips. emits a fragrant aroma in evening. Blooms repeatedly. 2'x3'wide, regular water.
Ruellia macrantha Russelia equisetiformis	To 3', erect. Large paired leaves, 2" deep pink bells. Coral Fountain - Shrub w/narrow arching branches to 4-5' tall by and as wide & red flowers spring-summer. Hardy to 25 F. Sun/ shade. Regular water. Hardy to 25 F.
Salvia chamaedryoides	Germander Sage - Evergreen to semi-deciduous shrub to 18-24" by 4' wide w/dark blue flowers year-round. Sun/Light shade. Little H2O needed. Hardy to 15 degrees F.
Salvia mexicana	Robust, up right. Large smooth leaves, deep blue flowers.

Sambucus nigra Black Lace 'Eva'	The lacy, finely-cut foliage is even darker than Black Beauty. If you didn't know better, you would mistake Sambucus Black Lace for a Japanese Maple. But unlike Japanese Maples, Sambucus Black Lace is an easy growing, durable shrub. The wonderful foliage is accented by creamy pink flowers that turn into red berries for the fall. 6-8 feet high and wide. Can be kept smaller with regular pruning or trained into a small tree.
Sarcococca hookeri var. humilis Sarcococca salicifolia Scilla natalensis	Shiny deep green leaves; small fragrant flowers winter-spring. Dense shrub to 5'; shiny narrow lvs, small fragrant flowers 3' tall spikes of starry bright or pale blue white flowers keep the excitement going for a month or more. Each exquisite flower is held outward from the main stalk on a long, delicate blue stem. Easy to grow in a well drained rock garden or container. Scilla natalensis forms rosettes of attractive upright pointed leaves which disappear in Fall. Best performance is achieved by watering & feeding till the leaves turn yellow-this will provide the bulb with plenty of energy for next seasons show. Hardy to 20°F, so in colder climates, do plant it in a container which can be brought indoors in winter.
Selago serrata	Erect to reclining evergreen shrub with stalkless, toothed, dark green leaves. Compact corymbs of fragrant light blue to purple flowers bloom in summer. Makes a good container plant or use in front of border. 1-3' high and wide
Senecio greyii Senecio kleiniiformis	4', bushy; grey stems, leaf margins; yellow daisy flowers Forms branching subshrubs with powdery blue cylindrical leaves. Leaves are tubular, flaring into cupped triangles at the tips. Compound flowers typical of the genus with pom-poms of tiny yellow or whitish flowers. Excellent blue accent for rock gardens or in the landscape. Performs well as a groundcover. Prefers porous soil with adequate drainage and bright light with ample airflow. Water thoroughly when soil is dry to the touch. Less water during winter months. Protect from frost.
Senecio mandraliscae	Kleinia - Succulent to 12-18" tall with blue gray cylindrical leaves and dull white flowers in summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. 15-20 degrees F.
Senecio vitalis	Densely packed, narrow, blue-green leaves grow in an organized fashion. 1' high and wide.
Sinningia tubiflora Solanum rantonnetii 'Variegated' (bush)	Clumping, to 1'+; furry leaves, fragrant white flowers. Evergreen shrub. Semi-shade. Striking variegated foliage. Fragrant bluish flowers in summer and fall. 6'x6'. Medium water. Heavy feeder. Does well with shearing.
Sonchus canariensis	Tree Sonchus - Tall upright growing shrub to 6-8' tall w/dissected leaves many yellow flowers in spring. Full Sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to +/- 25F.
Sonchus leptocephalus	From 3' to 5' tall, erect narrow woody branches are topped with finely dissected "horsetail" like leaves, creating a weird & wonderful accent specimen. Bloom season is March thru June when it bears sprays of bright yellow aster-like flowers. Grow in a sunny spot in rich, very well-draining soil. Excellent in a dry garden, rock garden, or cool in a large container.

Stachyurus praecox	This deciduous shrub grows to 10 feet high. Its growth habit is upright. The racemes of small flowers bloom in February and March when the shrub is void of leaves. The toothed leaves are glossy and bright green with a gold to red tint in fall. Leaves typically grow 3-5 inches long. Branches are cinnamon to purple in color. Spiketail grows in full sun but does best in light shade. It prefers well-drained, moist soil, Heavy frost will destroy the buds.
Strobilanthes (species) Symphoricarpos orbiculatus	Subshrub to 2'. Long, purplish lvs; light lavender flowers. Coralberry really shines in fall when it produces berries that range from pink to purple to wine-red. The berries persist through winter after the leaves have fallen. This dense, low-growing shrub, 3-5 feet high and spreads 4-8 feet can be used as a groundcover. It features long, cascading branches that serve as an interesting backdrop to the clusters of fall berries and the small, pink-white flowers that bloom June to July. But the bell-shaped flowers are no match ornamentally compared to the fruit. It is also drought tolerant and will adapt to full sun or part shade
Tabebuia chrysotricha (std.)	Golden Trumpet Tree - Evergreen tree. Full sun. Regular watering. Golden flowers bloom in spring. 25' tall and as wide. 25-30 degrees F.
Teucrium fruticans 'Azureum'	Bush Germander - Evergreen shrub to 4-5' tall by as wide with silver-gray leaves & deep blue flowers in summer-fall. Sun. Low water needs. Hardy to 0-10 degrees F.
Tibouchina urvilleana	Princess Flower - Semi-evergreen shrub. Light shade. Water regularly. Royal purple flowers in spring-fall. 6-8' tall and wide. 25-30 degrees F.
Tibouchina laxa Toona sinensis 'Flamingo'	Chinese Toona - Deciduous tree to 15-20' tall with showy pink spring foliage. Full sun. Water regularly. Hardy to 15-20 degrees F.
Trachelium caeruleum 'Hamer Pandora'	gorgeous, lightly scented, dark purple, lacy, dense & full flower heads up to 6" across. Blooming all summer to fall, this is an extremely valuable garden plant, wonderful in a corner or mid to back of border. Rich, shiny, dark purple tingled foliage is densely borne making a compact bush up to 3' tall by 3' wide! It loves part shade (to full sun by the coast) and loamy soil. SNAIL PROOF!
Tradescantia pallida (larger purple leaf)	A popular trailing house plant that has long, narrow pointed purple leaves. The herbaceous purple stems flop over which can look attractive in a hanging pot or as a creeper in a rock garden. It will freeze back in the winter in most climates. Small pink flowers bloom in the summer among the leaves. Plant in light shade or part sun and water regularly.
Tradescantia x andersonia (virginiana)	Clump forming 18" high and wide. Long grassy-looking, deep green, erect or arching leaves. Flowers last only a day, but buds come in a large cluster and plants are seldom out of bloom in summer.
Tristaniopsis laurina (std.)	Water Gum - Evergreen tree w/narrow dark lvs & yellow flwrs in spring. Slow growth to 45' tall (typically <25'). Sun/Part shade. Regular watering. To 20-25 F.

Urginea maritima	Sea Squill - Deciduous bulb w/2' long leaves in winter/ spring. White flower on tall stalks to 3-4' in summer. Full Sun. Low water needs. 20-25 degrees F.
Viburnum opulus 'Roseum' ('Sterile')	Shrub: Deciduous. Deer resistant. Clay tolerant. Have a snowball fight in June! Kids and adults alike love this rounded plant with masses of pink flowers. Nice cut flower. Attracts butterflies. Does not produce fruit because it's sterile. Height: 8-12 feet. Width; 10-12 feet. Exposure: sun/part shade. Water: moderate. USDA Z3.
Virburnum tinus 'Spring Bouquet'	Laurus tinus. 4-6', dense. Dark pink buds, white flowers.
Vitex trifolia var. purpurea	Spreading, w/purple-backed leaves, clustered purple flowers.
Wachendorfia thyrsoiflora	Large flower spikes rise to 6' tall and are covered with yellow 3/4" star-shaped flowers. The large sword-shaped leaves are attractively pleated. Found in marshes and along streams in South Africa, this plant is easy to grow in average garden soil or at the edge of a pond. Appreciates some compost though! Evergreen and blooms spring through summer. The rhizomatous roots can be used to make a reddish dye.
Watsonia	2 1/2' long sword shaped leaves with slim flower spikes set with smaller more trumpetlike, fragrant blossoms. Tolerates many soils but needs good drainage. Blooms in spring.
Weigelia 'Briant Rubidor'	Shrub: Deciduous. Deer & clay tolerant. Has pretty chartreuse foliage that changes with the season. Background, border, woodland & screen plant. Good cut flower. Attracts hummingbirds. Blooms: spring-summer. Color: ruby red, funnel-shaped flowers. Size: 4-8' x 4-9'. Exposurre: sun/part shade. Water: moderate. USDA Z4. (syn. W. florida 'Briant Rubidor')
Westringia fruticosa	Coast Rosemary - Evergreen shrub to 4-6' tall by 6-12' wide with drk gray-green lvs & white flwrs year-round (coastal) Full sun. Drought tolerant. 20-25 degrees F.
Westringia fruticosa 'Morning Light'	Coast Rosemary - Evergreen shrub to 3-4' tall by 4-5' wide w/yellow edged lvs & white flwrs year-round. Full/Part sun. Low-Medium water needs. 25-30 degrees F.
Westringia fruticosa 'Smokey'	Coast Rosemary - Gray-green, petite leaves edged in cream. Small white flowers bloom year-round. Hardy plant and good for coast. 4-6 ft. tall. Drought tolerant.
Woodwardia radicans	Thick leathery medium green fronds are upright but spreading toward the top. This fern can reach 6' tall x10' wide. Cascading fronds produce inch long bulbils at their tips that root when they touch the ground.
Xanthorrhoea preissii	Australian Grass Tree - Evergreen perennial with grass-like foliage that can get 10-15' tall x 6-8' usually much smaller. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to at least 20 F.
Xanthorrhoea quadrangularis	Australian Grass Tree - Unusual succulent-like plant to 6' tall x as wide w/ grass-like foliage & white flowers on tall spikes. Full sun. Low water needs. Hardy to 20 F.
Xylosma congestum	Shiny Xylosma - Evergreen shrub. Sun/Light shade. Occasional watering. 6-10'x 8-12'. 10-15 degrees F.
Yucca 'Blue Boy'	

Yucca filamentosa	lanceolate and slightly concave leaves are each to 2.5' long with thready margins radiates from the hidden ground-level stems on this evergreen clump of "shrub", with very tall inflorescences having creamy-white conical inflorescences range from 3' to 8' tall, blooming during July and August on thick, many-branched spires of semi-woody stems
Yucca 'Garland Gold'	Perennial Herb or Tree: Evergreen. Drought, deer and fire resistant. Nice border, container and cut flower plant. Pretty green foliage with a yellow center band. Attracts hummingbirds. Bloom time: summer. Flowers: fragrant white, bell-shaped. Flower stalks: 6-7'. Upright & clumping: 2-3' x 3'. Exposure: sun. Water: moderate. USDA Z4-9.
Yucca recurvifolia 'Gold Ribbons'	Evergreen succulent. Branched stems to 4-6' have yellow and green leaves w/white flowers in summer. Full sun. Drought tolerant. 20-25 degrees F.
Yucca rostrata	Silver Yucca - Slow growing succulent w/unbranched stems to 12-15' tall & flexible gray leaves. White flwrs in spring. Full sun. Drought tolerant 15-20 degrees F.
Yucca whipplei	Our Lord's Candle - Succulent with rosettes to 2' tall by 4' wide with narrow gray leaves. Full sun. Drought tolerant. Hardy to 10 degrees F.
Zantedeschia 'Gem Lavender'	Calla lily with a great shaped flower which is purple with lavender with a lighter edge is just beautiful.
Zantedeschia 'Mellenium Gold'	Summer blooming calla to 16-24" tall w/ golden yellow flowers. Good cut flower container or garden plant. Regular water. Full sun (coast)/light Shade.
Adenanthos sericea	6-20' high and wide. Silky silvery foliage with red flowers borne scantily throughout the year. Can be formed into small tree.
Asparagus retrofractus	Fluffy green tufts of foliage on climbing perennial.Grows slowly to 8-10'. Long lasting foliage can be used in floral arrangements. Full sun to part shade produces best growth results. Spring fertilization is recommended. Low maintenance plant with very little pruning required.
Myrtus communis 'Compacta Variegata'	Small-leaved form of this versatile, evergreen shrub w/ tiny, shiny, aromatic leaves, that are dark green w/ white edges, fragrant white flowers & blue berries.
Myrtus communis 'Variegata'	Shrub reaching 5-6' x4-5' wide. Glossy bright green leaves are variegated with a white edge. Leaves are fragrant when bruised. White, sweet-scented flowers bloom in summer followed by blue/black berries.
Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Tom Thumb'	This small shrub has new growth that is green turning to black-purple foliage with dark, fragrant summer flowers. True to its cultivar name, this pittosporum grows only 2 feet high so is ideal as a groundcover, in a container or a mixed border.
Abelia x grandiflora 'Aurea'	Growing up to 6' wide spreading with glossy green and gold-variegated leaves.
Buddleia davidii 'Santana'	An exciting new variegated butterfly bush with green leaves edged in bright yellow. They set off the purple-red flower panicles nicely from late summer well into fall. It's exciting coloring and texture make it a wonderful backdrop for other perennials. 7-8'tall x7' wide
